Rules and Regulations

1. Fighting: Any cadet starting or participating in a physical fight to include wrestling and any other physical contact with another cadet will be subject to immediate dismissal from the training and the cadet's return home at the parent's or guardian's expense.
2. Smoking, consumption of alcohol, drug use: Possession of or use of tobacco products, alcohol, or drugs will result in immediate termination of training. Authorities will be called in the case of illegal substances.
3. Weapons: Weapons will be confiscated if brought to training.
4. Contraband: A sea bag inspection will be conducted upon arrival. All items NOT on the allowed list will be confiscated and may or may not be returned at the end of training. Cadets who wish to travel with contraband items such as cell phones, MP3 players, books, magazines, and snacks will turn them in during sea bag inspection. These items will be returned at the end of training. Cadets caught with contraband after check-in will be sent home.
5. Inappropriate Behavior: Any cadet displaying inappropriate behavior will be counseled, given a Captain's mast, and may ultimately be sent home at the parent's or guardian's expense. Inappropriate behavior is defined as any behavior that, in the opinion of the Commanding Officer, NSCC/NLCC Training Contingent, brings disfavor or maligns the images of the NSCC/NLCC programs. We will not hesitate to send cadets home without graduating, even if the behavior occurs within moments of the graduation ceremony.
6. Lack of Motivation: Lack of motivation towards training will result in counseling, participation in a Captain's mast, and possibly being sent home at the parent's or guardian's expense. Lack of motivation is defined as failure to participate in training activities/classes, sleeping during activities/classes, being non-responsive to correction, or disrupting instructors or others in the class.
7. EEO, harassment, hazing, discrimination, fraternization: All personnel should review the NSCC policies noted in the "Standards of Conduct for All NSCC/NLCC Personnel" located here: [http://resources.seacadets.org/training/atm\\_appendix\\_1.pdf](http://resources.seacadets.org/training/atm_appendix_1.pdf) Respectful behavior among cadets, staff cadets, officers, and instructors is expected at all times.
8. Required documents: Cadets will print and bring all documents listed on the sea bag list for use during the training. Every cadet must have this form and a Medical History form (NSADM 020) in his/her record, updated after 1 February, 2013.
